These six tournaments comprise the Kamloops Grand Prix 2004, **rated by the Chess Federation of Canada**. You may play in all or any of them. Your updated national rating will be published approximately 2 months after each tourney.

A bye is worth $\frac{1}{2}$ pt. in the 4 rd. tourneys. Only one bye is available per player in a tourney. A withdrawal from a tourney is not a bye. An unforced bye in the final round is not permitted in any tourney. In the 6 rd. tourney, a forced bye is worth 1 pt., and an unforced bye is worth $\frac{1}{2}$ pt.

No computers, no alcohol, and no smoking allowed at site. You are responsible to supply your own equipment (pen/pencil, chess clocks if possible, chess set). Score sheets and boards will be supplied. Bring your CFC membership card. CFC memberships may be purchased at site.

Grand Prix Prizes

Each tournament will have its own prizes, based on entries

30% of all net revenue of the 6 tournaments will go towards funding for the Grand Prix prizes as determined by the number of points accumulated over the course of these 6 tournaments:

Note: All moves must be recorded on scoresheets unless there are only 5 minutes left on the clock.
